

# **“THE FINAL BATTLE & JUDGEMENT”**

*(Seventh in an 8 week series on “The Future Unfolded”)*

“People have asked the question why Satan will be loosed from his prison after the 1,000 years. “And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the key to the Abyss and holding in his hand a great chain. <sup>2</sup> He seized the **dragon**, that ancient **serpent**, who is the **devil**, or **Satan**, and bound him for a thousand years. <sup>3</sup> He threw him into the Abyss, and locked and sealed it over him, **to keep him from deceiving the nations** anymore until the thousand years were ended. After that, he must be set free for a short time” ... “When the thousand years are over, Satan will be released from his prison <sup>8</sup> and **will go out to deceive the nations in the four corners of the earth**—Gog and Magog—to gather them for battle. In number they are like the sand on the seashore. <sup>9</sup> They marched across the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of God’s people, the city he loves. **But fire came down from heaven and devoured them.** <sup>10</sup> And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. **They will be tormented day and night forever and ever.**”

<sup>11</sup> Then I saw a great white throne and **him who was seated on it.** Earth and sky fled from his presence, and there was no place for them. <sup>12</sup> And I saw **the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened.** Another book was opened, which is the book of life. **The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books.** <sup>13</sup> The sea gave up the dead that were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them, and **each person was judged according to what he had done.** <sup>14</sup> Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. The lake of fire is the second death. <sup>15</sup> **If anyone’s name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.**”

## THE GREAT REBEL ... (Revelation 20:1–3)

## THE LAST REBELLION ... (Revelation 20:7–10)

- ✓ **The Deceiver** – “Satan ... will go out to deceive the nations ... for battle”
- ✓ **The Deceived** – “the nations in the four corners of the earth... marched”
- ✓ **The Devoured** - “But fire came down from heaven and devoured them”
- ✓ **The Defeated** - “the devil, ... was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur”
- ✓ **The Duration** - “They will be tormented day and night forever and ever”

## THE ULTIMATE RENOVATION ...

*“But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. **The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare.** <sup>11</sup> Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives <sup>12</sup> as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming. **That day will bring about the destruction of the heavens by fire, and the elements will melt in the heat.** <sup>13</sup> But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to **a new heaven and a new earth**, the home of righteousness.”*

## THE DIVINE RETRIBUTION ... (Revelation 20:11–15)

### ➤ THE JUDGE

*“Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted **all judgment to the Son**, <sup>23</sup> that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him. <sup>24</sup> “I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. I tell you the truth, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live. <sup>26</sup> For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself. <sup>27</sup> **And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.** <sup>28</sup> “Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice <sup>29</sup> and come out—those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned. <sup>30</sup> By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and **my judgment is just**, for I seek not to please myself but him who sent me.”*

### ➤ THE JUDGED

*“But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, **you are storing up wrath against yourself for the day of God’s wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed.** <sup>6</sup> God “will give to each person according to what he has done.” <sup>7</sup> To those who by persistence in doing good seek glory, honor and immortality, he will give eternal life. <sup>8</sup> **But for those who are self-seeking and who reject the truth and follow evil, there will be wrath and anger.** <sup>9</sup> There will be trouble and distress for every human being who does evil: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile; <sup>10</sup> but glory, honor and peace for everyone who does good: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile... <sup>16</sup> **This will take place on the day when God will judge men’s secrets through Jesus Christ, as my gospel declares.”***

## ➤ THE JUSTICE

### ✓ The Books Balanced

“Then Jesus began to denounce the cities in which most of his miracles had been performed, because they did not repent. <sup>21</sup> “Woe to you, Korazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! If the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, **they would have repented long ago** in sackcloth and ashes. <sup>22</sup> But I tell you, **it will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon on the day of judgment** than for you. <sup>23</sup> And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted up to the skies? No, you will go down to the depths. If the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Sodom, it would have remained to this day. <sup>24</sup> But I tell you that **it will be more bearable for Sodom on the day of judgment** than for you.”
