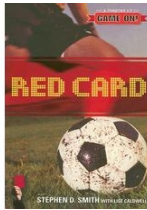
RED CARD

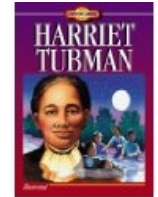
Confronts the old man who knows the secret of the treasure. Together Elijah and his friends begin to understand that God has plans for them beyond anything they have ever dreamed.
