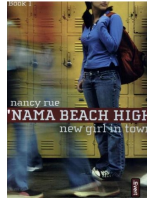
NAMA BEACH HIGH

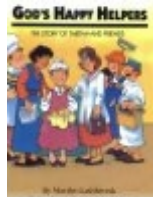
